# Information resources available via the Santa Cruz Public Library Website

As you use the library's datafiles, you'll be asked for your Library card number and password, so have them handy.

- 1. Go to <a href="http://santacruzpl.org/">http://santacruzpl.org/</a>
- 2. Click on Research



3. You can select a group of databases (e.g., Articles, News & Encyclopedias; Arts & Literature). For the purposes of this Guide, scroll down a bit and click on List A to Z (over on the left).



You're given access to 45 premium research databases to which the library subscribes, and an additional 60 or so high quality resources grouped by broad subject category.

# **EXAMPLE 1 Scroll down and click to bring up Ebscohost MasterFILE**
